<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will take digital pictures of different emotions showing=happy, sad, mad, afraid and confused. 	Powerpoint Kid Pix Google Docs

- Students will import digital photos into iPhoto and photo edit (crop, adjust etc.)
- Students will open Emotions template Powerpoint presentation and edit title slide with student name and correct date.
- Next the student will insert all digital photos each on a new slide.
- Once all images are inserted, students will add text to complete how they feel for each emotion and synonyms for each emotion. Change font size, color and style.
- Add a transition to each slide.
- Spell check with assistance finished presentation.
- Save and quit presentation.
